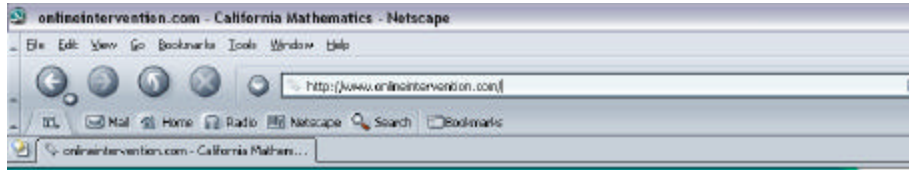
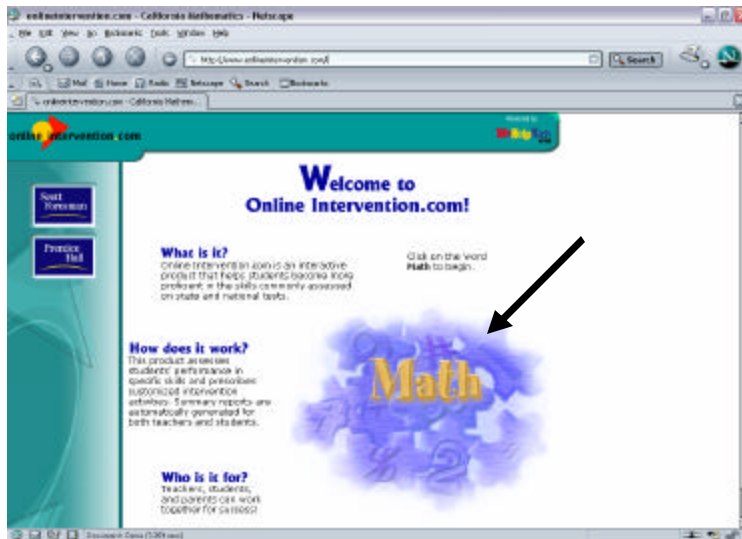


# Online Homework Help

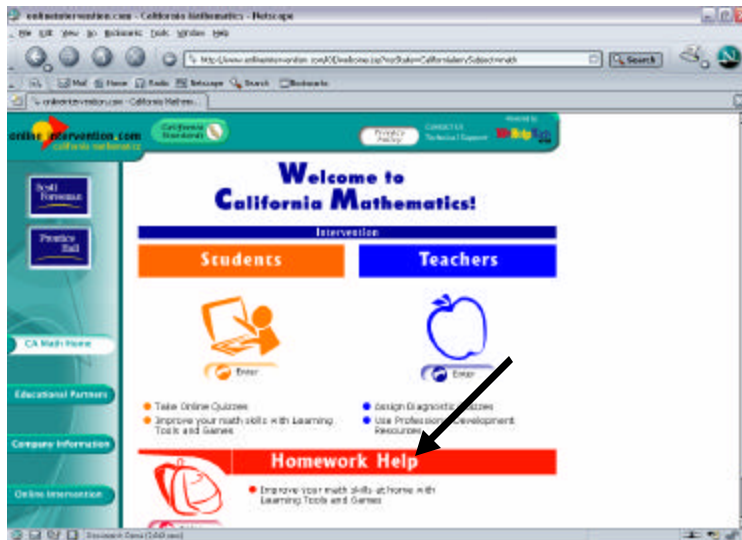
1. Open your internet browser and go to [www.onlineintervention.com](http://www.onlineintervention.com).



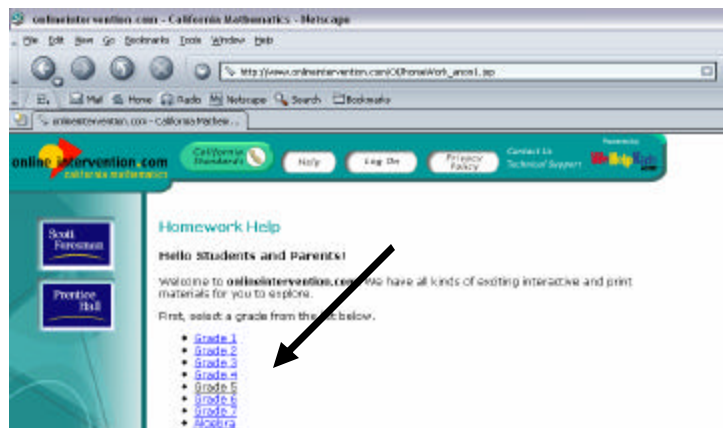
2. Click on the word "Math."



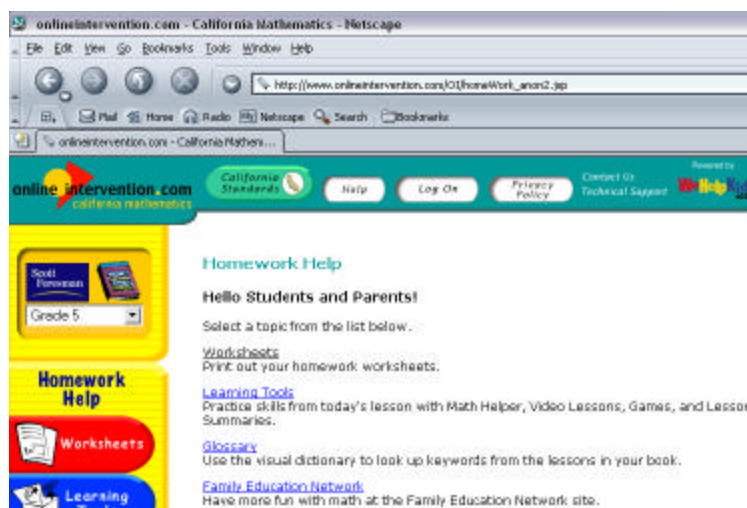
3. There are three choices: "Students", "Teachers", and "Homework Help." Click on "Homework Help."
